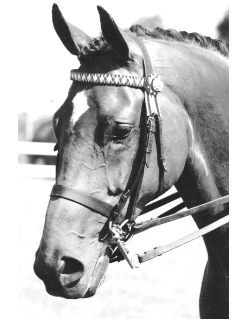

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter any or all of the classes.
2. £10 DEPOSIT is required on ALL Cups and they are the responsibility of the winning competitor whilst in their care. Cups **MUST** be signed for **By an Adult** and **RETURNED** to the Secretary **BEFORE** the next Show.  
**This is very important.**
3. Approved hard hats to be worn at all times when riding. Any rider not wearing approved hat must be responsible if injured.
4. In all cases, except affiliated classes the Judge's decision shall be final.
5. Any protest to be accompanied by a deposit of £10, which will be forfeited, if the Committee consider the protest to be frivolous or unreasonable or if the protest is lost. All protests to be made immediately following that class and before the next class.
6. All Brood Mares must have foaled or be due to foal in the current year. Brood mares without a foal must have a veterinary certificate. Foals should not be shown in bits.
7. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the appropriate Entry Fees. All cheques etc. to be made payable to the **LANIVET SHOW** and NOT to any individual.
8. Closing date for entries is 31st July 2011. Late entries and entries on the day will be charged at £1 extra without exception.
9. Competitors numbers to be collected from the Secretary's Office.
10. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
11. Any rider having a fall in the ring must leave the ring un-mounted and go directly to the First Aid Post for a check up.
12. All competitors and exhibitors should make themselves fully aware of the Health & Safety Standards at shows in accordance with guidance notes issued by HS Executive HM Agricultural Inspectorate and obtainable from HMSO.
13. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or damage.
14. No Competitor shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at any risk or injury.
15. **Any Stallion MUST wear a BLUE Tail Ribbon whilst on the Showground**
