

1st & 2nd placed horses/ponies in classes 3, 4 and 6-18 will qualify for the DCHPA Championships in 2011. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card ring which will enable the owner to enter that horse/pony for the DCHPA Championship show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become a member of the Devon & Cornwall Horse & Pony Association within 14 days of the qualifying show. No horse registration is required. For information telephone the DCHPA secretary on 01647 61803 or see www.devonandcornwallhorseandponyassociation.co.uk.

This Show is affiliated to the South West Ponies Association. Classes 3 and 4 and 6 - 18 are qualifiers and the two highest placed exhibits in each affiliated class that comply with the qualification rules of the relevant championship class will qualify. Recipients of cards must comply with the general rules of South West Pony Association and rules for championship sections, a copy of which can be obtained from the Secretary, Mrs Medwin Broad.

Classes 3 – 9 and 11 – 15 and 17 - 18 are qualifiers for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2011. 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed eligible horses/ponies in each affiliated class will receive a qualification card which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. This show is affiliated to the Equifest Showing Show 2011 and classes 4, 7, 8 & 12 are qualifying classes and the two highest placed eligible exhibits will receive qualification cards.

To qualify for the 15+ Horse & Pony Events 2011 Championship Show the first, second and third placed eligible exhibits in classes 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13 & 14 will each receive a Qualification Card. To enter the Championship Show the rider/handler and horse/pony must register with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 28 days of the qualifying show date. Rules & conditions of entry:

- Classes may be split, amalgamated or cancelled depending on entry numbers.
- The judge's decision is final at all times.
- Horses/ponies may be any age.
- **All stallion handlers to be 14 years old or over.**
- Any horse not handled correctly or considered dangerous will be asked to leave.
- Horse/ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
- Hats to current BHS standards to be worn at all times by handlers 14 years & under when leading.
- Whips or canes must not exceed 30".
- Any complaint must be handed to the secretary in writing on the day of the show along with a deposit of £10 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- All competitors and spectators attend at their own risk.

- Class 1 Best Turned Out** – any age, any sex.
- Class 2 Best Combination** – any age, any sex. Will be judged on compatibility of horse/pony and handler, presentation and overall picture.
- Class 3 Young Handlers - Mare or gelding**, any age. Handlers to have attained their 4th birthday before 1st January in the current year but not to have attained their 18th birthday before 31st August 2011. To be judged on the handler's presentation and showing technique. The pony will not be judged.
- Class 4 Best Colour** – any age, any sex. Will be split by colour if sufficient entries.
- Class 5 Youngstock** – 3 years & under, any type/breed, any sex.
- Class 6 Veterans** – 15 years & over, any sex.
- Class 7 Mountain & Moorland Ponies** – any age, any sex. Open to registered and unregistered pure-bred ponies but to qualify the pony MUST be registered with the relevant breed society of Shetland, Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh A, B, C or D.
- Class 8 Owner-Bred Mountain & Moorland Ponies** – any age, any sex. Open to registered and unregistered pure-bred ponies but to qualify the pony MUST be registered with the relevant breed society of Shetland, Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh A, B, C or D.
- Class 9 Part bred Mountain & Moorlands** – any age, any sex. Open to registered and unregistered part-breds but to qualify the part-bred MUST be registered with the relevant breed society of Connemara, Dales, Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Welsh A, B, C or D.

- Class 10 Owner Bred Excluding M&M** – any age, any sex, any breed/type.
- Class 11 Miniature Horses** – 42" & under. Any age, any sex.

Class 12 Show/Riding Ponies – any age, any sex. Not to exceed 153cm.

Class 13 Show Hunter Ponies– any age, any sex. Not to exceed 153cm.

Class 14 Hacks, Riding Horses & Hunters – any age, any sex. Hacks not to exceed 160cm. Riding Horses to exceed 148cm. Hunters to exceed 148cm.

Class 15 Cobs – any age, any sex.

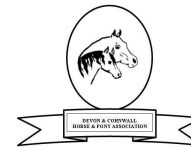
Class 16 Competition Horse/Pony Type – any age, any sex.

Class 17 Ex-Racehorses – Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with Weatherby's. The equine MUST have raced either on the flat, over jumps or point-to-point and MUST be entered in its registered name. To be judged on suitability to compete in all disciplines.

Class 18 Arabs, Anglo Arabs, Part Bred Arabs, Rare & Foreign Breeds (including European & American Breeds) – any age, any sex. Open to registered and unregistered horses/ponies but to qualify the horse/pony MUST be a registered pure-bred or a registered part-bred.
